PARADE PARTICIPATION RULES, REGULATIONS & CONDITIONS

Please pay particular attention to the following guidelines. They are for everyone's benefit and safety.

Candy or Giveaway Items: Throwing candy from vehicles or floats along the parade route is prohibited. Walkers must distribute candy or novelty items curbside.

Decorations & Costumes: All entries (except classic/historic vehicles) must be decorated, costumed and lighted to reflect the theme of the parade.

Drinking: No consumption or possession of alcoholic beverages or other illegal substances of any type is permitted. This rule will be strictly enforced.

Equestrians: Equestrians must be suitably diapered or provide their own clean-up crew. Please bring your own bags and shovels.

Floats/Motorized Units: Participating Floats, Cars, Trucks must be decorated and lit. Let the committee know if there is music on your float or units. Drivers must remain with their vehicles in case it needs to be moved.

Sound: Amplified sound units must be identified on the application form to allow the committee to arrange the parade line-up in an order that insures each entry can be fully enjoyed. No blowing of loud horns or sirens that drown out music played by bands and dance groups.

Parking: There will be no parking or dropping off in the parade lineup area. This creates a dangerous situation as people are lining up.

Reviewing Stand: All dance units and bands will be limited to a brief performance.

Vendors: All vendors who wish to participate must have permits. Contact the Town of Niagara Clerk's office at 297-2150 ext. 131 for more information.

Parade Marshals & Volunteers: Volunteers will be identified by (hat/vest). They must report to designated areas

Staging Area: 4th Avenue, Town of Niagara, New York.

Enter Staging Area from Porter Road NOT Military Road

Late Entries/arrivals: Any group who is not registered or arrives at the staging area late will be placed at the end of the Parade.

All parade applications and forms must be in our office by September 26, 2008. Please include a description of your float or unit on two 5 X 7 cards. These will be used for the judges at the reviewing stand.

ONLY ONE SANTA CHOSEN BY COMMITTEE WILL BE ALLOWED IN PARADE
